BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING: January 10 2015 @ 0800

Membership:

Currently we have 34 members, consisting of 14 full members, 17 probationary members, 1 water tender driver, and 2 volunteer Administrative Assistants. 4 members live on the mountain. We have 30 EMT's.

NOTE: 29 Members are active for shifts.

Apparatus and Equipment:

- All apparatus in service.
- E-7719 had a recall issued from International due to the possible failure of the double Cardan driveshaft to the front axle.
 Driveshaft has been removed. Engine is operational in two-wheel drive only for now. NO CHANGE IN STATUS
- New winch bumper from Buckstop Bumpers and a winch has been received and will be installed on Rescue 7789.
 - Skid steer has a flat rear tire. Mechanic will take care of.

Building and Grounds:

- County visit on January 5th. They looked at the station buildings and grounds.
 - Water usage report we used 9,430 gallons in December



Number of Calls per Day and Night Shift during 2014




Monthly Totals for the Calendar year 2014


Medical – Trauma/Medical
