BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING: February 7 2015 @ 0800

Membership:

Currently we have 36 members, consisting of 13 full members, 20 probationary members, 1 water tender driver, and 2 volunteer Administrative Assistants. 4 members live on the mountain. We have 32 EMT's.

NOTE: 32 Members are active for shifts.

Apparatus and Equipment:

- All apparatus in service.
- E-7719 had a recall issued from International due to the possible failure of the double Cardan driveshaft to the front axle. Driveshaft has been removed. Engine is operational in two-wheel drive only for now. NO CHANGE IN STATUS per National Highway Traffic Safety Administration website.
- New winch bumper from Buckstop Bumpers and a winch has been received and will be installed on Rescue 7789.
 - New front tires installed/sway bar repair on R-7789
- Flat repaired on Skid Steer 79. New chains acquired to help with moving snow.
 - New Type 6 will be in sometime in April

Number of Calls on Each Day of the Week during 2015




Number of Calls per Day and Night Shift during 2015
