	CALFIRE SRA supplementary grant for fuel reduction beyond 100' defensible space (\$200,000) submitted by PMFSC (9/28/16): Includes improvement of Birch Hill Borland-Conifer Rd. contingency evacuation route to allow 2 way access/egress all passenger and larger emergency fire/medical vehicles. Not funded. To be revised and resubmitted at next SRA funding opportunity. Consent of owners needed for BirchHill/Crestline contingency road improvement before resubmission.
