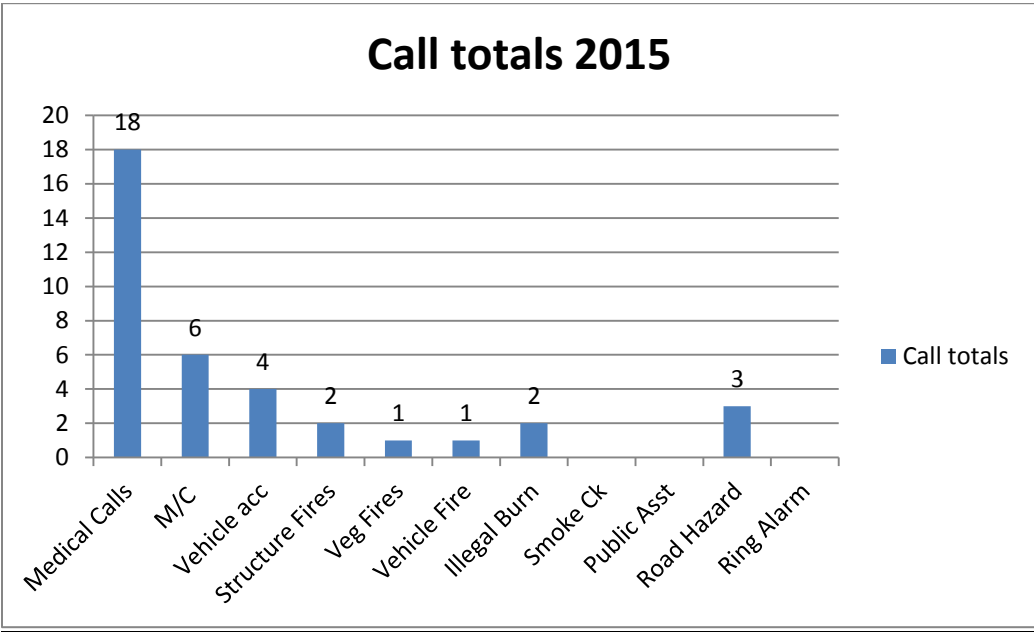

Number of Calls on Each Day of the Week during 2015

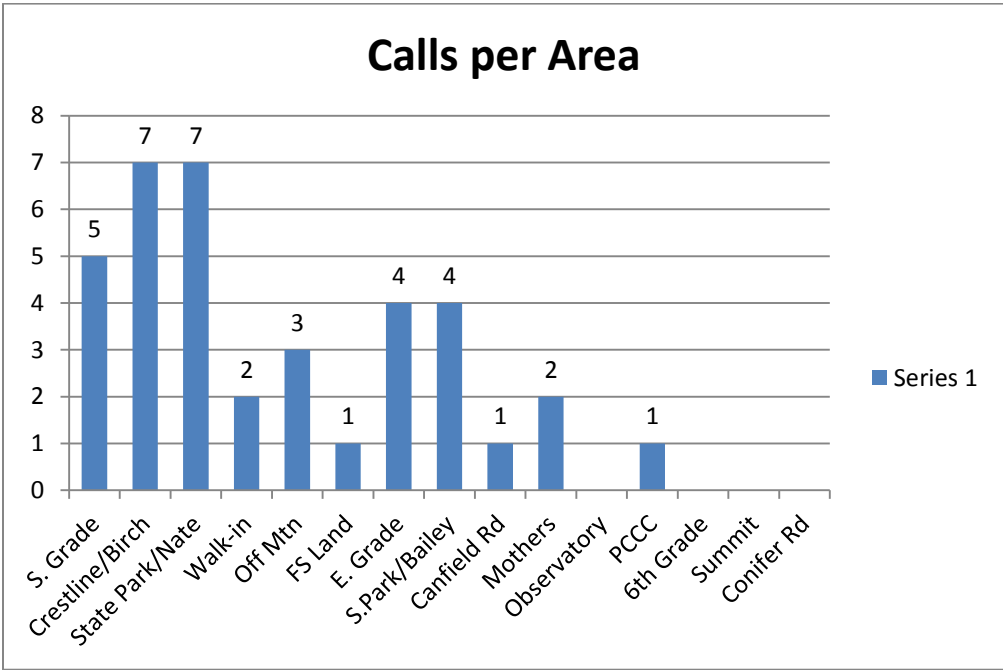

Number of Calls per Day and Night Shift during 2015

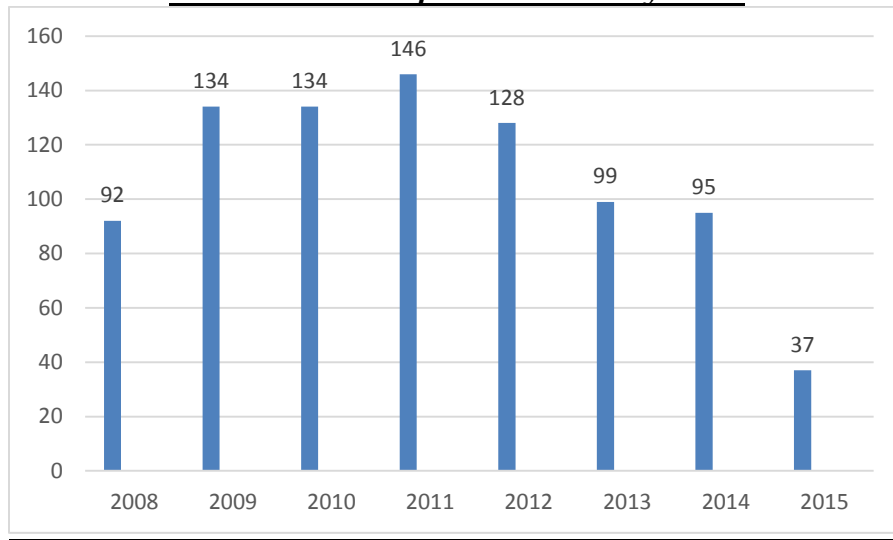
