Volunteer Reserves:

- 23 members
- New spreadsheet created to track Volunteer Reserves
- Lack of drivers

Apparatus and Equipment:

- E7719 - out of service pump failure. \$20,000-\$25,000 estimate to fix. Temporary engine provided by County until new Type 1 is delivered in 2016.
- E7710- Near rollover incident on Boucher Point Road. Engine out of service. To date damage at \$14,200. Engine will be "laser measured" to determine any damage to frame and axles.
- Type 6- In service. Multiple drivers have been trained and signed off.
- R7789- Currently out of service. (3) repairs since last board meeting. Clutch, starter and transmission. \$6500-\$7000.
- Equipment- Porta Count machine sent out for calibration
- SCBA Filling Station- Air leak on compressor. In process of being repaired.

Building and Grounds:

- Exterminator service started
- New beds/frames have been ordered. Delivery in August.
- County looking at contacting with Department of General services for station maintenance

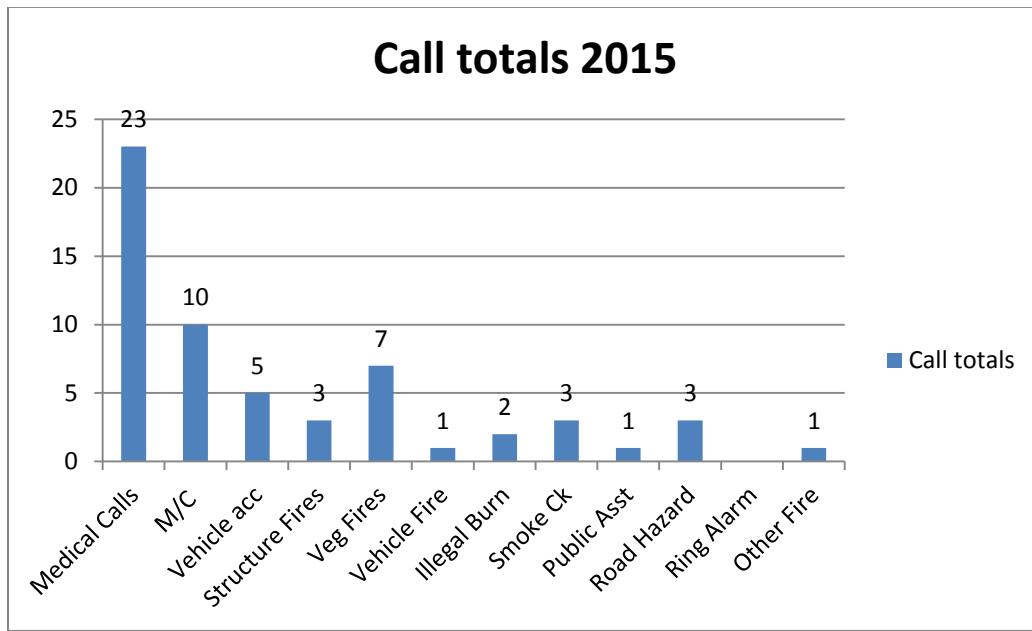

Number of Calls on Each Day of the Week during 2015

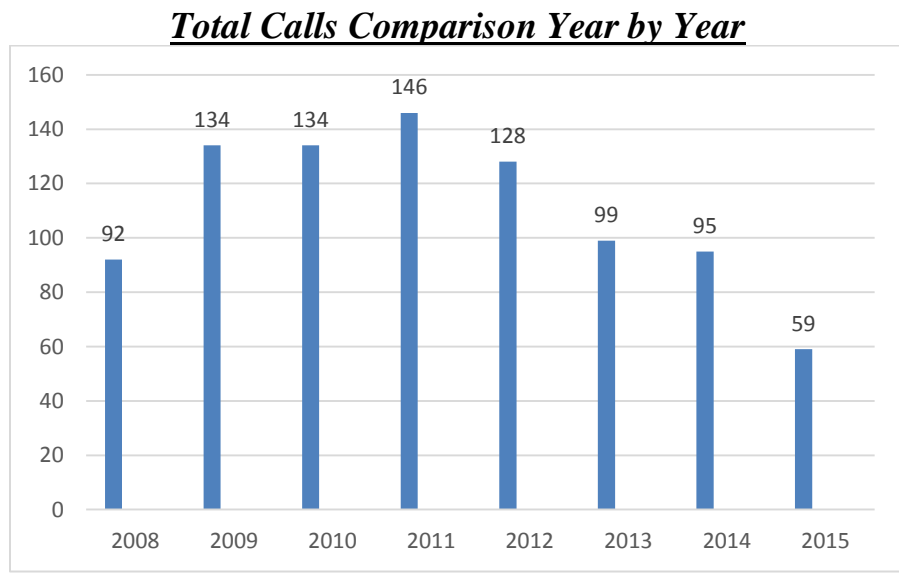
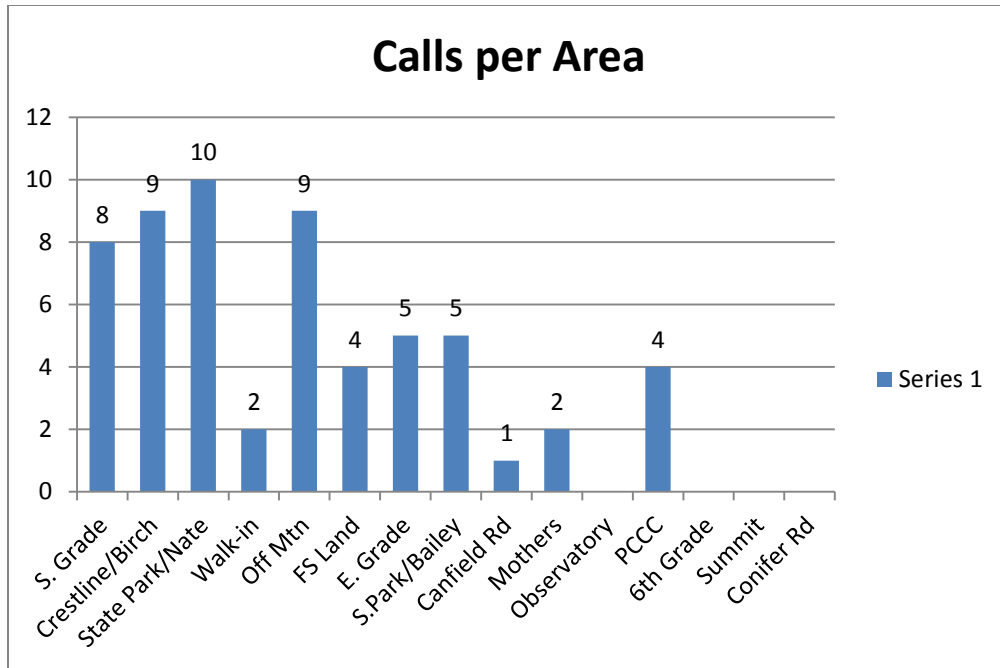
