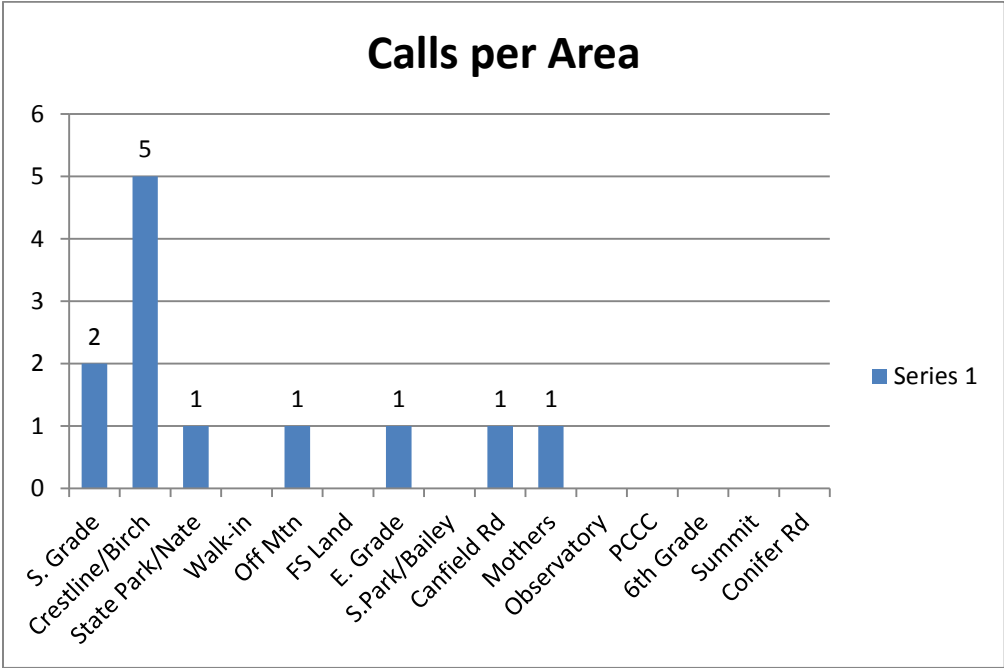
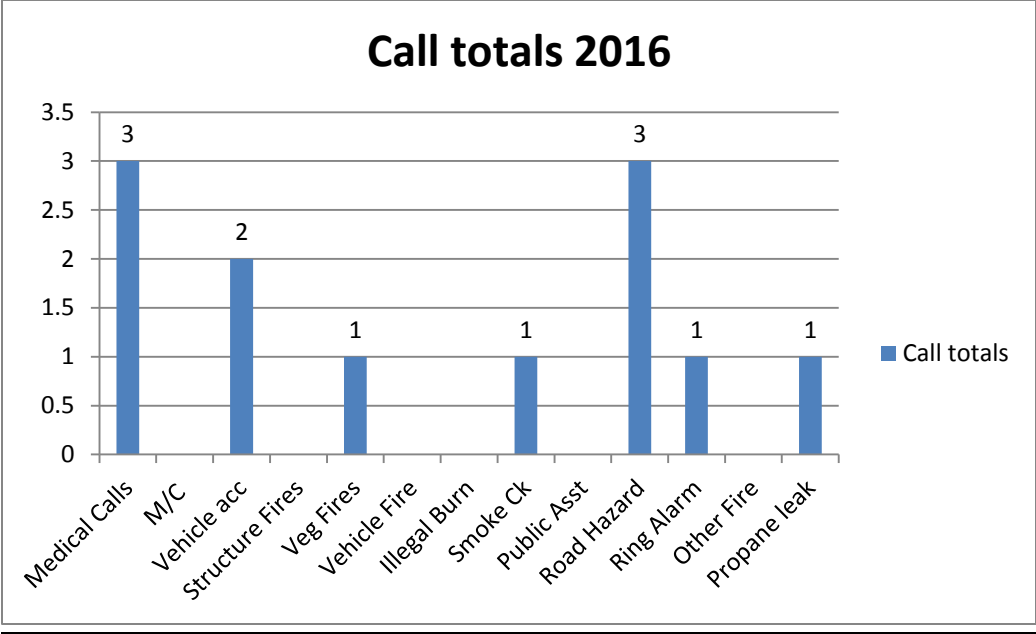

Number of Calls on Each Day of the Week during 2016

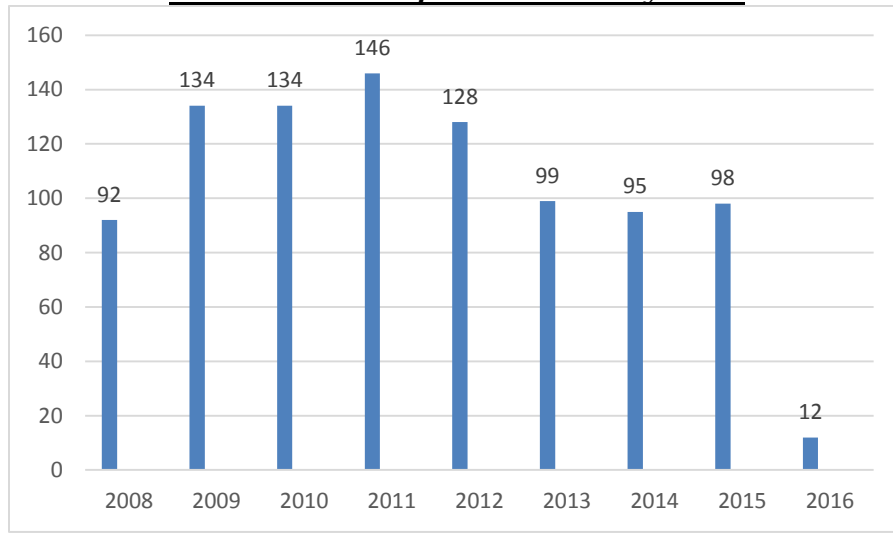
