Priority Project: Evacuation Routes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Assess condition of alternate East and West routes (access through Wall's and Borland's properties from Crestline, BirchHill) and High Point Road -Liaise with CAL Fire, USFS, Sheriff's Dept., PMFD, CERT, Community Center, re alternative routes from both (Birch Hill) and West sides of South Grade, evacuation instructions, provisions for post-evacuation access. -Update 2008 Evacuation/Temporary Evacuation site brochure as needed -Inform PM community of standard and alternate routes, evacuation/post-evacuation instructions, temporary evacuation/assembly sites
