Building and Grounds:

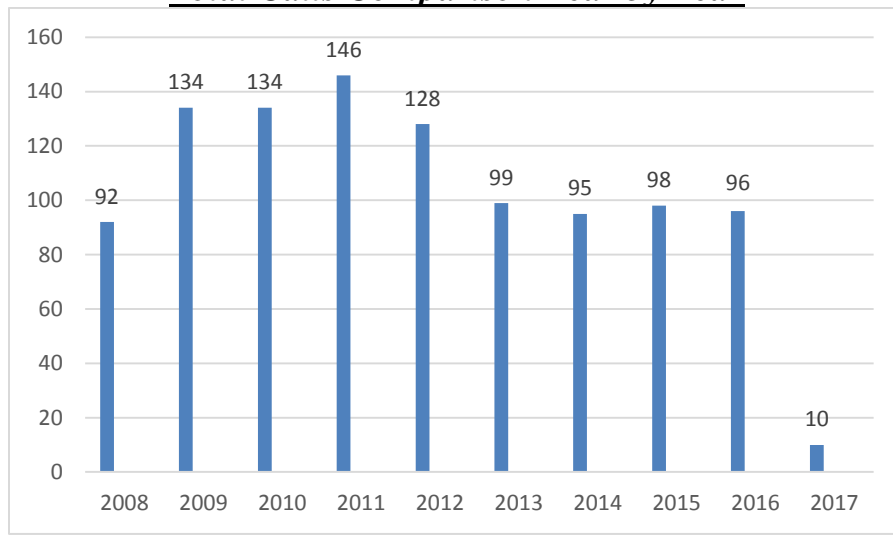
- Electrical work continuing for App Bay- New powered Door Openers
