## **7P's of Emergency Evacuation**

**Plan** – Evacuation route out of your community (primary and back-up); how family members will contact each other; where you should meet. Fill your gas tank at the first opportunity.

**People/Pets** – Who gets the children, pets; pet carriers, leashes are accessible.

**Papers**, phone numbers, and important documents. Deeds, birth certificates and other irreplaceable documents should be in one location so these can be grabbed at a moment's notice. Better – scan or photograph these to the cloud.

**Prescriptions** – medications, eyeglasses, hygiene items, special health equipment. You may be gone from your home for days, so insure you have access to all your health related items.

**Pictures**, irreplaceable memorabilia. Priceless items that could be lost forever.

**Phone, Personal** computers, any information stored on hard drives and disks. Include charging cords (keep one in car). Better – automatic back-up programs.
